

NATIONAL HIGHER EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP (NEMZETI FELSŐOKTATÁSI ÖSZTÖNDÍJ) – CRITERIA OF NOMINATION

Minimum requirements:

- the general average of grades has to reach at least 4.50 per term and the student has to obtain 55 credit points altogether in the preceding two semesters
- In case of completed Erasmus semester: 28 credits can be accepted, for the other semester beside the general average of grades at least 4.50 per term, completion of 27 credits is needed.

Obtainable scores by fulfilling the minimum requirements:

I. ACADEMIC STUDIES (max: 80 points)

- **General average of grades**
(average of the last two semesters' average –4.00)*80
- **Other** (max: 10 points)
 - Language exams, obtained in the application period:
 - o second B2, type C language exam certificate 5 points
 - o C1, type C language exam certificate 7 points
 - o professional 3 points

II. PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES (max: 120 points)

Members of the Department are asked to suggest points separately to each activity.

- Research activities; Undergraduate Research (TDK),
National Undergraduate Research (OTDK) achievements (max: 60 points)
- Publications, conference presentations, projects (max: 50 points)
- Other professional and academic competitions (max: 40 points)
- Other important professional and education activities (max: 30 points)
(e.g., demonstrator)

III. PUBLIC, SPORT AND OTHER ACTIVITIES (max: 20 points)
